Americans with Disabilities Act

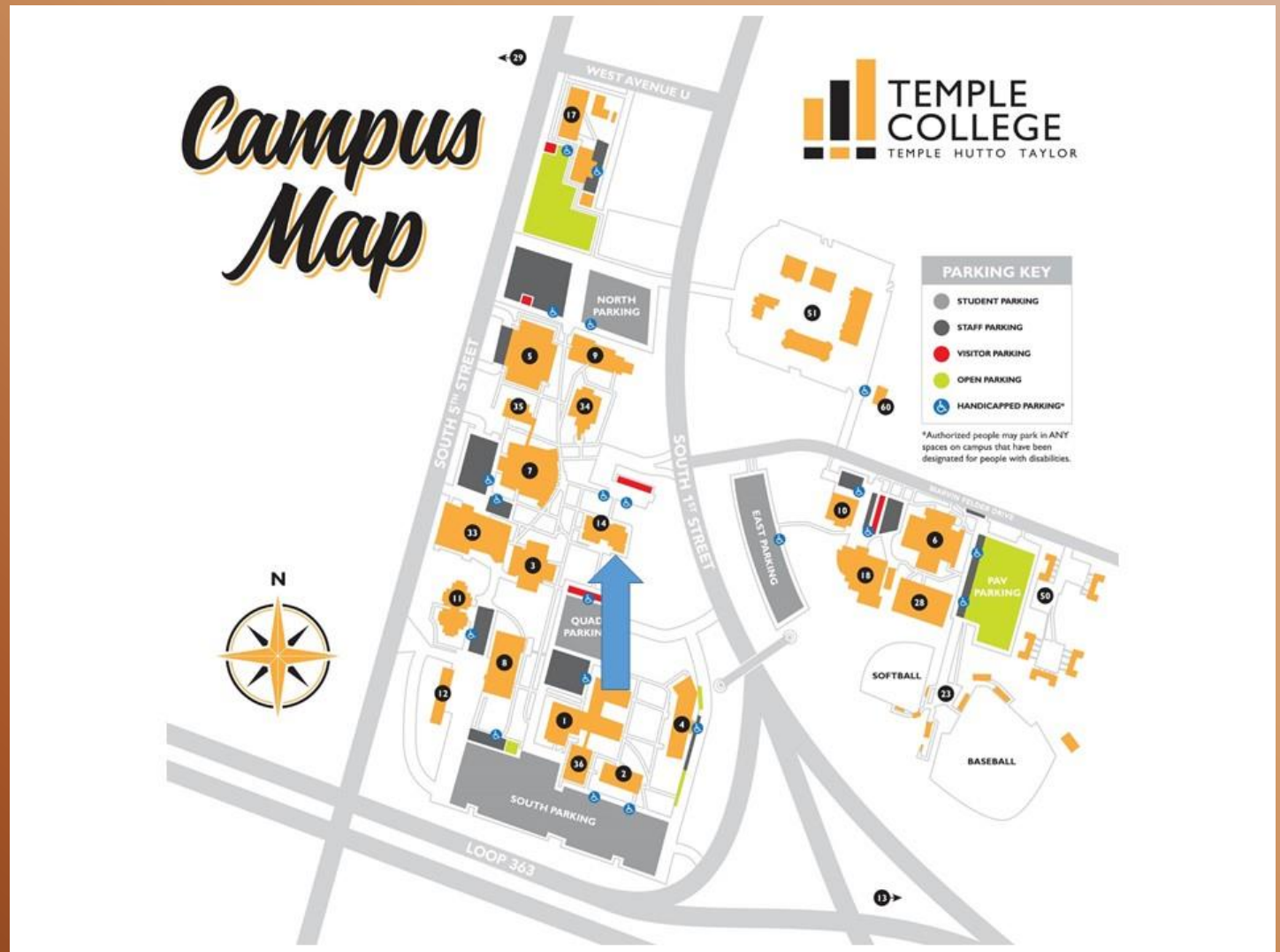
