How Do I Get Financial Aid?

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at:

www.FAFSA.ed.gov

- Application is free
- Help is available in the Financial Aid Office

BEWARE OF SCAMS requiring fees to complete the FAFSA or to help you find financial aid resources.



When Do I Apply for Financial Aid?

- Application deadlines
 - Fall Semester - June 1
 - Spring Semester - November 1
 - Summer Semester - April 1
- Accurately complete the FAFSA to avoid time delays and potentially being dropped from classes

The FAFSA must be completed every year!



Why Apply for Financial Aid?

- Most scholarship applications require completion of the FAFSA
- Nothing to lose; **everything to gain**
- \$30 - \$40 million has been awarded at Temple College
- Further **YOUR** education for a better future



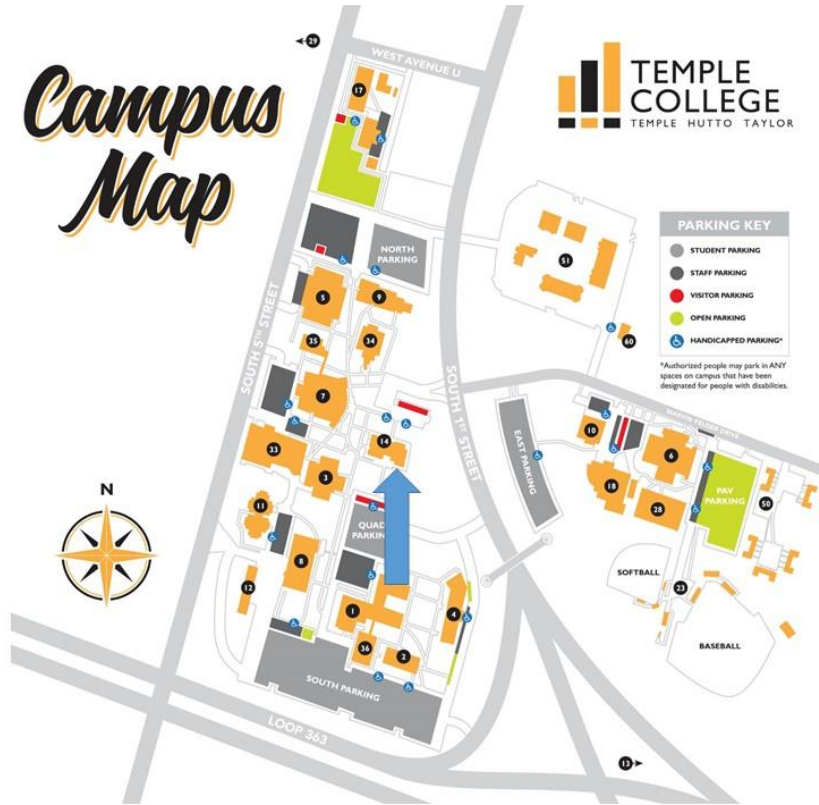
How Will I Receive My Financial Aid?
