

Need to Withdraw from a Class?





What is a Withdrawal?

- Action that occurs when a course is removed from a student's schedule
- A withdrawal is recorded on your Temple College transcript and will be listed as a "W"



How to Withdraw

- Speak with your instructor
- See an advisor before withdrawing from your classes
- An advisor can assist you or you can withdraw online using TConnect



How to Withdraw

- If you want to withdraw from ANY developmental class, see your advisor
- If you withdraw from your only developmental class, you will be dropped from all other classes



6 Drop Rule


- No more than 6 drops allowed throughout entire undergraduate college career in Texas
- Drops transfer from institution to institution



IMPORTANT!

- If you are using <u>any</u> federal funds, see Financial Aid or your advisor <u>BEFORE</u> withdrawing
- You may owe a portion of tuition & fees
- This could impact future Financial Aid disbursements
